

Sixth Form Dress Code

Students are expected to wear **smart business attire**, as if attending a formal meeting or job interview. Students should either wear clothing with a formal collar, such as a shirt, or a blazer or formal jacket. Students should always wear their ID lanyards.

This could consist of:

- A smart suit with a shirt and tie
- A shirt or collared blouse
- Formal trousers or skirt of an appropriate length
- A formal dress of an appropriate length accompanied by a blazer
- Smart turtleneck or v-neck jumper or another professional top accompanied by a blazer
- Smart shoes

Students are NOT permitted to wear:

- Sportswear- only for PE
- Hoodies or casual jumpers
- Casual T-shirts, low cut, backless, off-the-shoulder or strappy tops, clothing that shows bare midriffs, undergarments showing, backless tops or off the shoulder
- Denim, including black jeans
- Leggings
- Leisurewear
- Short skirts, bodycon dresses or skirts
- Shorts
- Trainers, plimsolls, canvas shoes (e.g. Converse), extremely high-heeled shoes, sliders, flip-flops, sandals, casual boots (e.g. UGGs and Timberland style footwear)
- Jumpers must not have large or bold logos

Guidance on other items:

- Subtle makeup and jewellery can be worn however unprofessional items will not be permitted
- Artificial nails can be worn but no extreme lengths
- Outside coats, scarfs, hats and gloves should not be worn inside the building
