GROW FARM

We grow vegetables, fruits and flowers for the TTA canteen and local community.

We sell our produce at our weekly stall in the TTA car park every Thursday.

We also run a weekly veg box scheme from May-November every year.

GROW OUTDOORS

We run early support programmes for referred groups of students who need additional support with their well-being.

We run 3 groups a term for Y7-Y9. Over 10 weeks, students learn sustainable food growing knowledge and mindfulness techniques.

CLUBS

Y7 & Y8 lunch club runs every WEDNESDAY lunch.

Y7 after school club runs every MONDAY 3:15pm-4:45pm.

We run holiday clubs for Y7 free school meal recipients and SEND children.

AQA COURSES

We run a variety of AQA courses for 14-18 year olds at risk of not continuing in education, employment or training.

Our current courses include AQA Mushroom Cultivation and AQA Floristry. Courses take place throughout the year & students can be referred.
